5 FOR SIX SCHOLARSHIP

An Investment in Student Success

The 5 for 6 Scholarship is awarded to individuals without a high school diploma or equivalency who wish to enroll at a Louisiana community or technical college.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What determines eligibility?

Eligible recipients:

- Are currently enrolled in WorkReady U or other Adult Basic Education program,
- Have NOT received federal financial aid in the past,
- Do NOT currently qualify for federal financial aid, and
- Have NOT earned an Ability to Benefit [ATB] qualifying score on ACCUPLACER.

SUBJECT	QUALIFYING SCORE
SENTENCE SKILLS	60 or higher
ARITHMETIC	34 or higher
READING COMPREHENSION	55 or higher

How much is the scholarship?

The amount of money awarded to each student will equal the tuition charged for 6 credit hours.

Does the scholarship cover all fees associated with the courses?

No. The scholarship covers all fees except for course-specific fees. Not all courses charge course-specific fees. You may ask the Admissions Office for help with selecting courses without course-specific fees.

Will I receive a check?

No. The 5 for 6 Scholarship will be applied to your student account.

What does “5 for 6” mean?

The “5” comes from colleges setting aside 5% of tuition increases, and the “6” is to cover costs associated with taking 6 credit hours to qualify for additional aid.

How do I apply for the scholarship?

STEP 1

REMAIN ENROLLED in the program that is assisting you to obtain your high school equivalency.

STEP 2

APPLY for admission to a college by visiting their website.

STEP 3

REGISTER for 6 credit hours of non-remedial classes.

- Call the Admissions Office.
- Identify yourself as a “5 for 6 Applicant.”
- Ask for assistance with registering for SIX credit hours.

STEP 4

MONITOR YOUR E-MAIL account and LoLA to learn if you have been awarded The 5 for 6 Scholarship.

STEP 5

PAY YOUR FEE BILL if you registered for classes with course-specific fees. Access LoLA to pay your fee bill.

STEP 6

PURCHASE YOUR TEXTBOOKS. Your College may cover this cost for you. Check with the Financial Aid Office.

What if I am not awarded The 5 for 6 Scholarship?

Being eligible does not guarantee that you will be awarded a scholarship. Scholarships are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis. If you do not receive the scholarship, ask the Financial Aid Office if other funding options exist.
