SUBJECT: Naming of a Prominent Space within the Delgado River City Site
in Honor of N. J. "Woody" Oge'

FOR BOARD ACTION

Recommendation: Staff recommends that the Board authorize Delgado Community
College to name the atrium of the River City Campus the "N.J. 'Woody' Oge Atrium" in
honor to the contributions made to the college and the campus.

Background: The River City Campus, as an Act 360 project, is nearing completion and
will soon be occupied by Delgado Community College. While many individuals played
some part in making this project a reality, it is also in part, as a result of the efforts of Mr.
N.J. "Woody" Oge who served in multiple capacities as not only an LCTCS Board
member but also as a member of Delgado Community College Foundation and as a local
community leader in the greater New Orleans region. Given this, and with the recent
passing of Mr. Oge, the Delgado Community College Foundation felt if appropriate to
request, through Delgado Community College, of honoring the memory of Mr. Oge by
naming the atrium of the River City Campus as the "N.J. 'Woody' Oge Atrium." Note
that prior to taking any formal action, it may be necessary for the board to suspend
provisions of LCTCS policy #4.003 "Naming of LCTCS Facilities" related to excluding
facility naming privileges for "past members for a period of two years from service on the
board". With that said, the foundation and the college resolve that this is an appropriate
manner in which to honor the years of service and dedication of Mr. Oge towards the
maritime industry, Delgado Community College, the Louisiana Community and
Technical College System and ultimately, the citizens of Louisiana.
